NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Public Hearing, as provided by law, will be held by the City Council of the City of Thousand Oaks, to consider and decide the following matter:

The composition of districts to transition the City from an at-large election system to a by-district election system for City Council pursuant to California Elections Code Section 10010(a)(1).

This Public Hearing is scheduled to be heard by City Council on **Tuesday, May 16, 2023, at 6:00 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, in the Andrew P. Fox City Council Chambers/Scherr Forum Theatre, City Hall, 2100 Thousand Oaks Boulevard, Thousand Oaks, California 91362.

City Council will hold a series of public hearings to educate the public on the process and requirements, engage the community in this process, and solicit residents' opinions on district boundaries. There will be a presentation by the City's demographer on how the public can participate and compose district maps.

Any person is privileged to attend and be heard on this matter. Professional simultaneous interpreters will be present. If you would like to speak on this item you may fill out a speaker card at the meeting or, if you wish to speak via video conference and/or teleconference, please register at www.toaks.org/agendas.
