The Thousand Oaks City Council is holding a district formation public hearing on Tuesday, **June 20, 2023** during the regularly scheduled City Council meeting at 6 p.m. National Demographics Corporation, the City's professional demographer, will present the first round of draft maps to City Council for consideration.



Draft maps submitted by **June 6, 2023** will be processed by the demographer and published to maptoaks.org/draft-maps on **June 13, 2023**.

Map Submission Deadlines and Participation

There is still time to draw a map! Mark your calendars with the following dates:

JUNE 6, 2023 – Deadline to submit maps for consideration at the third public hearing

JUNE 20, 2023 – Third public hearing to review draft maps submitted by June 6, 2023

JUNE 27, 2023 – Final deadline to submit maps for consideration as part of the process

JULY 11, 2023 – Fourth public hearing to select a map for adoption
