On **June 20**, the City of Thousand Oaks' City Council selected focus maps for consideration at the fourth public hearing on **July 11**.

At the public hearing, City Council will discuss the focus maps and any additional maps submitted by the **June 27** deadline. Once a preferred map and sequence of elections are selected, the City Council will adopt the final map and introduce the ordinance.
