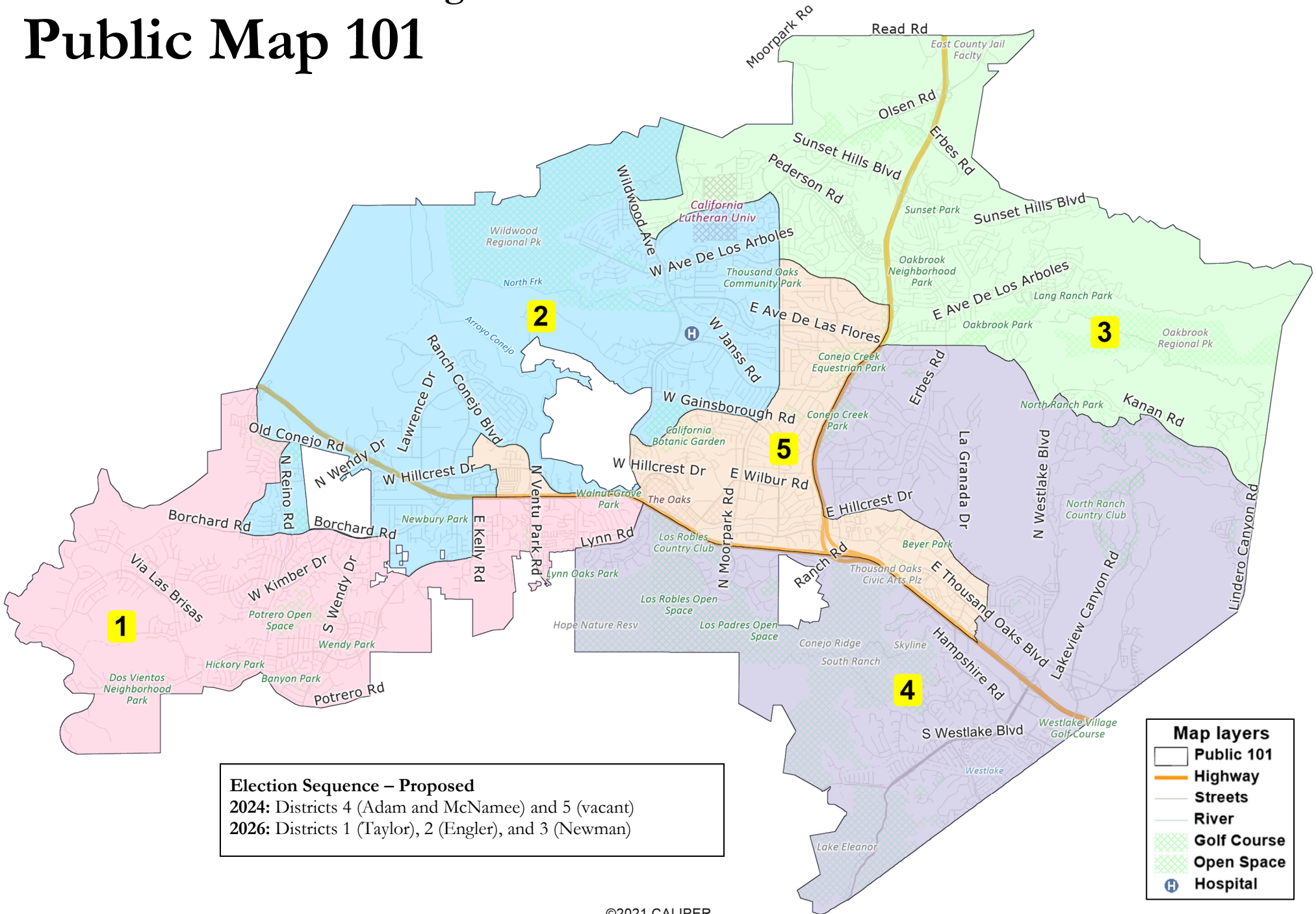


Thousand Oaks Districting 2023
