Any map which removes the Borchard Parcel from Newbury Park south of the 101 is unacceptable.

-The Borchard Parcel & NP south of the 101 are in the same "community of interest" & the voting rights act requires that communities of interest remain together.

-Splitting out the Borchard Parcel disenfranchises the residents of NP who will be most affected by development of that property. The voting rights act seeks to prevent this.

-After looking at all of the maps I support map 104. It seems to be the fairest.
